



One of Cobb County's oldest high schools is currently undergoing a nearly \$48 million dollar SPLOST funded welcomed change to its campus.



#### LAND USE (ZONING)

- With help from concerned neighbors, defeated a high-density development on Queen Mill Road, a
   QuikTrip proposed for Riverview Road and an AutoZone proposed for Veterans Memorial Highway
- Worked with applicants to improve the quality of six new neighborhoods approved during the year
- Participated in all of Commissioner Sheffield's monthly In The Zone meetings and brought affected neighbors into the meetings
- Advocated for code amendments to the county's Future Land Use Map
- Continued advocating for and secured the public's access to virtual participation in zoning hearings as a safety measure during the pandemic
